**There were full houses when live performance returned for three nights at the end of June.** As COVID restrictions had not been lifted fully, capacity was reduced to 50%. For those lucky enough to come along, safety was the watchword. A one way system funnelled everyone up the new ramp, under the new canopy and in to the climate controlled theatre. Interval drinks were served at table. Served up on stage and screen were a series of some of the Group's greatest hits. Sketches from plays were performed live but as there could be no live singing musical excerpts were on film. Backstage, performers were kept in bubbles with no mingling. It was all a bit strange as mingling with your mates is a big reason for getting involved. Still, for performers and audience alike it was great just to be up and running.

**The Youth Section has kept busy and engaged during the great unpleasantness through regular classes on Zoom.** Maria Bailey and her team look forward to welcoming everyone back for live classes on 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> September. **Thank you to all those who took part in the consultation for members and season ticket holders.** The responses showed, largely, that there was a groundswell of enthusiasm to get up and running again. However, there are those who are hesitant and anxious; we understand.

**As part of the Group's commitment to keep everyone safe, our secretary, Jacky Fletcher, has secured a licence for the theatre under the "See it Safely" scheme.** The scheme follows Performing Arts Guidance issued by the DCMS and features 6 priority actions for everyone to follow. A health and safety assessment been carried out. The new climate control system is designed to help provide adequate ventilation and a strict cleaning regime has been implemented. People can check in by using the NHS QR code poster. Finally, we will make sure that procedures put in place are carried out. Because the safety of everyone in the building is paramount, this is not a box ticking exercise. The procedures were put to the test successfully for *DAG Returns!*

**Although restrictions were relaxed on 19<sup>th</sup> July and enable us to perform to full capacity audiences, in line with several other groups and companies the Group has decided to play to a reduced two thirds capacity.** In deciding to do so, it is acknowledged that, for now, not all people will want to sit shoulder to shoulder with people they do not know. The attached seating plan shows how social distancing will be maintained. Although no longer mandatory, all front of house staff will each wear a face mask; as a courtesy to others, the Group strongly encourages the continued use of face coverings by everyone.

**Please see the attached request/reminder about payment of membership and season ticket fees.** The cost of season tickets has been held at £65. Should the season be curtailed, a proportionate discount will be carried over to the next season. There is a slight increase for general ticket sales to £12.
