

Celebration and Anticipation

As the last production of our very successful 60th Anniversary Season approaches I hope that you've enjoyed it as much as we have. From the first scrum down to the last throat slit, it's been a ball!

Our final production of the season, the popular DAG Musical, is Sondheim's Sweeney Todd the Demon Barber of Fleet Street.

It won't be a surprise, to those of you who know him, that David Fletcher chose this Sondheim. Not only does it celebrate DAG's 60th Anniversary but also David's imminent 80th birthday. After 48 productions for the group, including 32 full length musicals and numerous sets, David is looking forward to revisiting this fabulous musical.

Sweeney Todd is a fictional character who first appeared as the villain of the penny dreadful serial The String of Pearls (1846–1847). The original tale became a feature of 19th-century melodrama and London legend. A barber from Fleet Street, Todd murders his customers with a straight razor and gives their corpses to Mrs. Lovett, his partner in crime, who bakes their flesh into meat pies. The tale has been retold many times since in various media.

This version stars the music and invention of Stephen Sondheim and Hugh Wheeler. The original Broadway cast had Angela Lansbury as Mrs Lovett and Len Cariou as Todd; in London it was Sheila Handcock and Dennis Quilley. It has continued to be performed ever since its first outing in 1979; with the third Broadway revival in 2023. Obviously worth another outing for us too, after our first production in 2000. My Mother Said was an emotional one for our audiences but it also had moments of high drama interspersed with gentle comedy. It was wonderful to welcome the rest of the original cast and director to our Sunday Matinee and gratifying that they enjoyed the performance.

They were not alone; feedback on the production was brilliant with several people saying it was the best bit of drama that they'd seen for some time.

Two One Act Plays (Plus One) saw the production of two original pieces plus a one man play by Chekhov – On the Harmful Effects of Tobacco. An evening with a murder mystery, a downtrodden but well-meaning husband and a French farce was bound to be a success; and it was.

The exhibition of David Wood's paintings was very much enjoyed and quite a few people went home with their own piece of David Wood. The exhibition runs until the end of Neville's Island.
